We shall not be responsible for any other loss or damage that may arise through the use by a purchaser or others of this device, and the purchaser assumes such responsibility and will hold Hybrinetics, Inc. harmless in respect to all such loss or damage.

WARNING: To reduce the risk of burns, electrocution, fire or injury to persons:

1. Use this converter only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer. Do not plug converter into an extension cord.
2. Never operate this converter if it has a damaged plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped or damaged, or dropped into water. Return the converter to factory for examination and repair.
3. Never obstruct air circulation to converter.
4. Never drop or insert any object into any openings or holes.

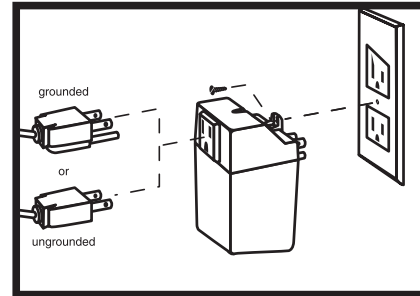

5. Do not use outdoors.



1. Turn off power to the receptacle at the fuse box or circuit breaker.
2. Remove screw from receptacle cover plate. (Do not remove cover plate).
3. Plug converter into lowest outlet. Place screw through converter screw

ring and cover plate and tighten screw.

4. Turn on power to receptacle.
5. Insert your appliance plug into the converter.

Caution

1. To prevent electric shock or fire, connect directly to a grounding receptacle.
2. To reduce the risk of electric shock: Disconnect power to the receptacle before installing or removing the converter. When removing receptacle cover screw, cover may fall across plug pins or receptacle may become displaced.
3. Use only with 120 volt AC duplex receptacle having center screw; and secure unit in place with receptacle cover screw.
4. Do not place or store converter where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
